This Year's Theme: "**FLAGS AND FOOTBALL**"

- The competition is open to elementary, middle and high school students, with first second and third being recognized from those three divisions.
- Designs should be drawn in 2D, with special emphasis on football and saying thank you to the U.S. Armed Forces with patriotic symbols, colors and themes.
- Students are also encouraged to include their favorite **college** football elements: favorite local teams (TCU, Texas, Texas A&M, Texas Tech, SMU, Oklahoma, etc...); bands, cheerleaders and mascots.
- Media is open, materials: paint, crayon, colored pencil, collage, ink and other. Be colorful and creative.
- The entry must be submitted on the official 8 ½ x 11 sheet showing the LMAFB and FWISD logos. The sheet has been emailed to you to print out for your students and is also available online at www.armedforcesbowl.com/artcontest.
- Winners will be recognized with a prize pack at the Lockheed Martin Armed Forces Bowl luncheon on December 22nd, and receive tickets to attend the game on December 23rd at Amon G. Carter Stadium on the campus of TCU.
